**Re: Signing of a Memorandum of Understanding with First Polish Client**

The Company is hereby honored to announce that on March 17, 2022, Trucknet Enterprise S.R.L., an incorporated subsidiary of the Company in Romania (hereinafter: '**Trucknet Romania**') signed an MoU with Polish company Fabryka Wezy Gumowych I Tworzyw Sztucznych 'Fagumit' Sp. z.o.o (hereinafter: the '**Client**') for use of the Trucknet Platform, in any territory periodically agreed upon in advance by the Parties.

The Client will be entitled complimentary use of the Trucknet Platform for a trial period of 21 days starting from March 22, 2022. Following the trial period, and insofar as the Client continues to use the Trucknet Platform, the Client will pay Trucknet Romania a monthly fee in the amount of 500 Euros (plus VAT), for the first three months, after which the Client will pay a monthly fee of 700 Euros (plus VAT). Furthermore, the Client's subcontractors, who provide haulage services, will pay Trucknet Romania for any smart match created via the Trucknet Platform, a total of 5% of the transportation price.

The MoU stipulates that the Parties will endeavor to promote mutual cooperation with the aim to implement the Trucknet Platform in the Client's systems and assess that such implementation process will be completed within 60 days from the date of the MoU.

The Memorandum of Understanding is for an indefinite period and each Party may terminate it by providing 30 days prior written notice.

The Company estimates that successful cooperation between the Parties, in accordance with the MoU, will lead to exposure of the Company and the Trucknet Platform to additional companies in Poland, who may also enter into an agreement with the Company.

It shall be hereby clarified that there is no obligation on the part of the Client to use the Trucknet Platform to any extent. Furthermore, the Company's assessments regarding the likelihood of additional companies in Poland choosing to engage with the Company, constitutes projected information, as defined in the Securities Law.



This information is based on the Company's subjective assessments, based on the information provided to it, and its materialization, depends on various factors that are not under the Company's control, such as the Client's satisfaction with the Trucknet Platform over time and the desire of additional Polish companies to utilize solutions offered by the Company. It is clarified that these assessments may not materialize, in whole or in part, or materialize in a different manner from that assessed by the Company.
